

Transportation

Highways

Highway #401 (providing 12 lanes of traffic between Toronto and Pickering) is the major east-west expressway providing ready access to Toronto, Ottawa, Hamilton and the nation's other commercial and industrial centres. Other provincial highways serving the area are Highways #2 and #7 (east-west) and Highway #407 ETR, which extends into Pickering.



These important highway networks have made trucking and warehousing an important industry in Pickering and full carrier service for local, provincial and international freight is readily available. Major logistics and trucking companies in the area include The Shandex Group, Bedwell Van Lines, RDP Fulfilment and ADS Logistics.

Interurban Transit

The Government of Ontario's (GO) Rapid Transit System links Pickering by bus and rail with Toronto, Hamilton, Oshawa, and major points in between. Typically trains run every 20 minutes during rush hours and every hour at other times until shortly after midnight. Travel time to Toronto's Union Station is approximately 40 minutes (25 minutes express). Regularly scheduled Durham Region Transit Authority buses connect with the Pickering GO Station. Now under construction is an enclosed pedestrian bridge and 500-space GO Parking structure. This bridge will span Highway 401 and connect the GO Station to downtown Pickering.

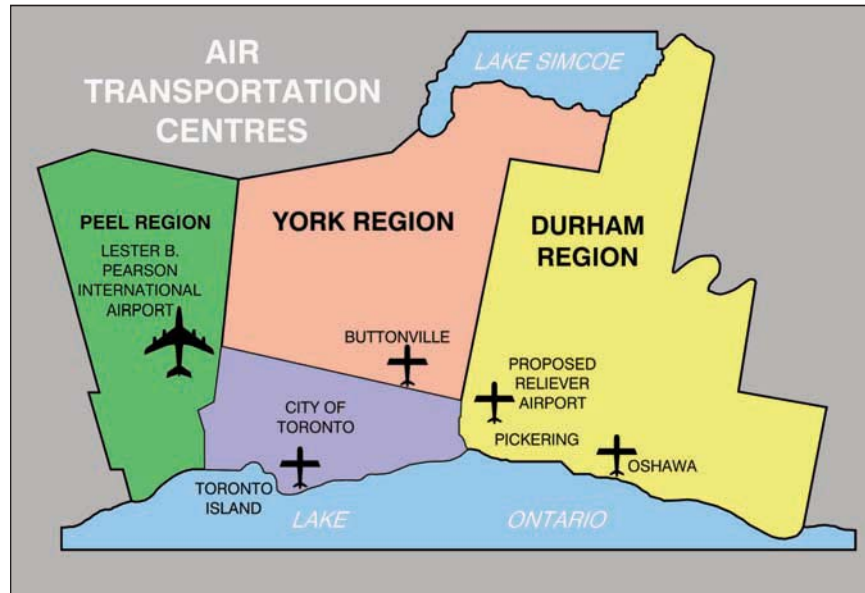
