**OPG CUTS RIBBON ON 777 BROCK ROAD FACILITY**

Ontario Power Generation (OPG) President and CEO and Pickering Mayor Wayne Arthurs were on hand recently to officially open OPG's new office building at 777 Brock Road, just north of the Pickering Nuclear station.
