Indo-Canadian Cultural Association

Following a presentation from the Indo-Canadian Cultural Association, Council endorsed the concept of renaming the Esplanade Park to the Peace Park and the garden circle, the Lester B. Pearson circle and referred to staff for consultation. The association noted that by renaming this area the City is demonstrating its commitment to peace, non-violence and reconciliation.

Boards & Committees News

Council appointed Councillor Littley as the City representative on the **Toronto & Region Conservation Authority Trail Guidelines Advisory Committee.**

Council endorsed the recommendation from the Pickering Museum Advisory Committee to nominate Laura Drake for the **Cultural Heritage Award**, under the Heritage Community Recognition Program.

Council endorsed the recommendation from the Heritage Pickering Advisory Committee to nominate Gordon Zimmerman for the **Built Heritage Recognition Award** under the Heritage Community Recognition Program.

Don Beer Arena Accessibility Improvements

Council accepted the proposal from Jurecka + Associates Architects to provide architectural services for the design of accessibility and operational improvements at the Don Beer Arena.

Municipal School Crossing Guard Program

Council approved the tender from Staffing Services to provide for school crossing guards for the period of September 2009 to June 2012.

Council also approved tenders for;

- Tennis Court Resurfacing Project at Kinsmen & Maple Ridge Park by the Court Contractors Ltd.
- Walkway lighting at Amberlea and Rouge Valley Parks by Wayne Electric Co-Ltd.
- The 2nd Lawn Bowling Green by Melfer Construction.
